Amendment of the Permanent Mandate on UWB to reflect the repeal of Commission Decision 2007/131/EC.

Dear Mr Woolford,

On 14 May 2019 the Commission adopted an Implementing Decision (EU) 2019/785 *on the harmonisation of radio spectrum for equipment using ultra-wideband technology in the Union and repealing Decision 2007/131/EC*.

The Permanent Mandate to CEPT on UWB (RSCOM17-04rev3), submitted to CEPT in 2017, refers in several places to the repealed UWB Decision 2007/131/EC. It was therefore necessary to make editorial amendments to the text of the mandate.

Following the consensus in the RSC, I am pleased to send you the amended mandate on UWB (enclosed as document RSCOM17-04rev4).

I would appreciate to continue receiving from CEPT the deliverables specified in the mandate, along with an explanatory note on how the tasks have been executed.
