#### Thursday, 3 April, 12:45 - 14:15: The Regional Internet Registries: Supporting Community Development

The five Regional Internet Registries play a key role in the development of their diverse membership communities to ensure the stable operation of the Internet, Capacity building. community engagement and development of best practices are all areas in which the five RIRs work closely with their respective communities. This lunch will showcase some examples of RIR efforts in these areas from around the world.

### Sunday, 6 April, 12:45 - 14:15: ICANN: The New gTLD Programme: Opportunities and Innovation

ICANN, in its role as a steward of the Domain Name System (DNS) has been involved in the introduction of new generic Top Level Domains (qTLDs) into the root of the Internet. During the lunch an update on the Programme will be given along with examples as to how diverse and non-Latin speaking Communities will use the new Names to foster innovation and consumer choice.
