PostEurop


- → 52 European Public Postal Operators



- Participation in the RCC UPU roundtable in Minsk, Belarus (June 2015)






Memorandum of Cooperation UPU-PostEurop-RCC on the PostEurop Neighbourhood Programme (25 September 2014)

- To build on the mutual interest of the European Postal Operators, and in some specific cases also their neighbours, in promoting:
 - Operations and Quality of Service improvement
 - Accounting and Remuneration
 - Customs
 - Security
 - Deeper cooperation in the fields of Postal Regulatory Affairs, Postal Social Affairs, Postal Operational Affairs and Postal Market Affairs based on specific needs expressed by PE Members
- International Organisations potentially involved in the PNP:
 - UPU, RCC, Other Restricted Unions, EU, IPC, World Bank, EBRD, etc.


